



Hello everyone.

I have been able to confirm our booking for the Thursday 7th August at Scenic Rim Farmshop and Elderflower Farm. They are open for breakfast from 8.30am and close at 4pm. They also have a lunch menu if you wish to spend the day there. **We cannot take our own food.** As you can see from the photo, the tables are set out under the wonderful trees. It is such a serene setting as it is on a quite country road. If it is showery, they will set us up in the barn. On the property is a local produce shop, flower and herb

gift shop, clothes shop, café. Next door is the Elderflower farm and I have been told that, although they are not open to the public on a Thursday, if we contact Rachael prior to the day, we could possibly be able to tour it, if staff is available. Having spent some time there recently with a friend, I found a few hours was all that we needed.

There is another option for lunch. The Dugandan Hotel in Boonah has been highly recommended by Peter and friends. It is 20km from the farm and has senior meals available. I haven't made a booking for lunch so please let me know if you would like to eat there.

As it looks like it will be a bit of a drive there and back, I have included a map with suggestions for a round trip. Depending on where you start, it could take about 90 minutes one way. I drove via Cunninghams highway and turned left into Kengoon Rd then right into Kents Lagoon Rd. Hope this is helpful. Also, if anyone is able to take someone else, please let me know.
